CONDITIONS

- 1. Full barricading affixed with 'Road Closed' signs (as designated under the *Qld Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*) shall be erected at all closed intersections and the applicant shall be responsible for any fees incurred;
- 2. Police or accredited traffic control officers shall be deployed at all intersections along closed roads and the applicant shall be responsible for any fees incurred;
- 3. This permit may be cancelled or the conditions altered by a police officer for the safe and effective regulation of traffic, or the safety of the general public and participants;
- 4. All roads shall be re-opened at the nominated times and any remaining participants of the associated event shall complete the event utilising footpaths or, where safe to do so, the far left side of the roadway;
- 5. The Qld Fire and Rescue Service, Qld Ambulance Service, City of Gold Coast and the Queensland Taxi Council shall be advised of the road closures;
- 6. The applicant shall advise in writing, all owners / occupiers of businesses and residences located along roads which will be closed, either partially or fully, of the road closure/s and the associated event;
- 7. The applicant shall advertise all road closures and traffic deviations in a relevant major newspaper, covering the region the event will be conducted in, at least two days prior to the event date;
- 8. The issue of this permit does not exempt the applicant from obtaining any relevant permit or authority required by another authority, occupier or owner, e.g. Local Government, Department of Transport and Main Roads, private property owner, lease holder, etc.;
- 9. A copy of this permit (and all associated permits) shall be held by the applicant or nominated person during the event and shall be produced to police if required.
